

As we reflect on the last year, we are filled with gratitude and hope. Hope - for the well-being of the thousands of cancer patients and thier loved ones who utilized our services.

Once again, we are very pleased to report exponential transformation and growth. Our Board of Directors and Staff advanced our strategic plan and furthered our goals of reaching more British Columbians affected by cancer, offering timely and relevant programs & services; enhancing our operational effectiveness; demonstrating our value; and maintaining our financial sustainability.

We enhanced and established partnerships in communities and with healthcare colleagues and the provincial government. A highlight of the year was our move to the Centre for Cancer Prevention and Support. The purpose of the move was to provide convenience to patients undergoing treatment in Vancouver, while enabling us to work more closely with partners in the cancer care precinct. Our bright, uplifting space is designed to provide a warm, nurturing and healing environment for our patients and caregivers.

Transitioning out of the global pandemic, we embraced a new normal. More people returned to our centres and reconnected in-person with our services, reaffirming the importance of face-to-face contact and care. As well, recognizing not everyone has access to our offices, we expanded our virtual services through our ongoing digital transformation. This hybrid model of care remained a vital lifeline for those needing support across the province. Our commitment to accessibility remained at the forefront of our efforts, especially as we prioritized underserved populations and rural and remote communities.

Stakeholders in Kamloops requested our services and with their incredible help and determination, we piloted a community outreach model of cancer care. The Kamloops Cancer Supportive Care Society and the Royal Inland Hospital Foundation were instrumental in making this possible. Through a combination of virtual and in-person programming, patients in Kamloops and its surrounding communities were offered support in navigating their cancer journeys.


#### **Our True North**

# InspireHealth enhances the quality of life of those living with cancer.

With compassion we focus on a patient's physical, emotional, and spiritual health by providing evidence-informed, person-centred care where the patient plays an active role in their care plan.

Our clinical team provides integrative supportive care guided by the patient's values, priorities, and goals.

We support patient choice and empowerment and promote self-care through knowledge and skills-building.



We believe in health equity, social justice, and non-discrimination, and provide supportive care services throughout a patient's cancer journey regardless of demographic, socio-economic status, gender, ability, or origin.

We recognise the value of immediate, peer, and broader community relationships in a patient's recovery and provide support for those who care for the cancer patient.

Through collaboration and a shared purpose, we work with other healthcare providers and organizations to identify and fill gaps in a patient's cancer treatment and add value to the health system whereby patients benefit from 'the whole' rather than 'the parts'.

We provide leadership to broaden understanding of the benefits of supportive cancer care.





### **Anjali's Story**

When I first discovered a large tumor while washing my hair, I was shocked and couldn't believe it when my doctor confirmed the diagnosis. With two young children, the thought of not being there for them was devastating. My first visit to InspireHealth was to talk with a counsellor about how to tell my sons.

After my double mastectomy, I joined low-impact exercise classes at InspireHealth, which were crucial in helping me regain my range of motion. The support I received, including guidance from a dietitian, was invaluable in managing both the physical and emotional aspects of cancer.

When I experienced treatment fatigue, a physician at InspireHealth took the time to understand my values and helped reframe my perspective, giving me the strength to continue treatment.

As I transitioned back to "normal" life, it was reassuring to know that InspireHealth continues to be there for me. I want others to know that they have the power to change the course of their cancer journey through the programs and services at InspireHealth.



# **Transforming Lives Across Our Communities**



Cancer incidence in BC is growing rapidly, attributable to both the increase in total population and our aging population. In the next ten years, new cancer diagnoses will increase from 34,000 to 45,000 annually. In addition, approximately two-thirds of British Columbians diagnosed survive five years or more, increasing the demand for comprehensive survivorship support.

### **Supporting Underserved Communities**

By prioritizing these communities, we aim to bridge gaps in health services and provide support where it is most needed, ensuring that everyone has access to the tools and resources necessary for well-being. We are committed to supporting BIPOC populations and providing cultural safe supportive care for patients.

#### **Rural and Remote**

We provide essential support and navigation for patients through our hybrid model of care, removing both geographic and financial barriers to access and bringing much needed supportive care services to rural & remote communities and vulnerable populations in all corners of the province.


# **Kamloops - The Power of Collaboration** in Transforming Healthcare

This past year, we were able to make significant impact on the lives of cancer patients in Kamloops, a community underserved in supportive cancer care services. By bringing our in-person, foundational 2-Day LIFE Program to the community supported by our virtual offerings, we were able to help 100 people affected by cancer with over 1,500 one-on-one appointments and classes.

This was made possible through collaboration with key stakeholders in the community including the Kamloops Cancer Supportive Care Society, Royal Inland Hospital Foundation, Royal Inland Hospital Cancer Clinic, Thompson Region Division of Family Practice, Thompson Rivers University, and the Le7 te Melamen Health Society (formerly the Secwepemc Health Caucus).







# **Ron's Story**

In March 2022, I went in for what I thought was a routine colonoscopy, but my world changed when I woke up to the news that I had Stage Two colorectal cancer. My wife and I were stunned, facing uncertainty about what lay ahead.

Cancer quickly began to impact every aspect of my life. Seeking help with managing treatment side effects, I turned to InspireHealth. Initially, I received nutrition support, but soon found myself benefiting from their counselling services, exercise therapy, and group programming. The community of fellow cancer patients at InspireHealth has been a crucial part of my journey.

The comprehensive care I've received at InspireHealth has been life-changing. Their holistic approach, the philosophy behind their services, and the dedicated staff have guided me through this journey, addressing my needs both physically and emotionally. The availability of free, supportive care resources in one place has been remarkable.



# Comprehensive Programs and Services

Support for Every Stage of the Cancer Journey



#### **Supportive Care Team:**

Our team is comprised of supportive care **physicians**, **counsellors**, **dietitians** and **exercise therapists** along with **guest experts** and **experienced facilitators**. Together, they provided individualized and group support through our virtual platform, and in-person through our Vancouver, Victoria, and Kelowna centres and through outreach in communities such as Kamloops.

Research shows that supportive care, such as exercise & nutritional therapy, counselling & mental health services and a community of support, improve cancer outcomes.

#### **Essential areas of patient support include:**

- Managing the side effects of cancer treatments
- Stress reduction and mental health support
- Reducing loneliness and isolation during cancer
- Nutrition support & exercise therapy for better recovery and outcomes
- Improving sleep and reducing fatigue
- Supporting challenges related to sexual health & well-being
- Managing work, life, and relationships
- Navigating cancer diagnosis & treatment



# **Classes & Workshops**



#### **Exercise**

Our exercise and movement classes are designed to support strength and mobility needs during and after treatment.



#### **Nutrition**

Our nutrition workshops and cooking classes play an important role in supporting patients through their recovery.



#### **Mental Health**

Our counsellors and physicians support a patients mental health and emotional well-being through our workshops and mindfulness practices.



#### **Education**

Our educational sessions cover important topics in cancer care such as lymphedema, sexual health, post-surgery rehabilitation and more. 1,000

classes and workshops offered over the year.

### **Multi-Week Programs**



#### **InspireHealth Signature LIFE Program**

InspireHealth's highly regarded and comprehensive 2-Day LIFE Program was updated and re-launched this year. The Program provides patients and their loved ones with the essential foundations of health and wellbeing during cancer. Participants learn about stress reduction, sleep management, self-care, nutrition, exercise & movement, lymphatic and immune system support, and healthy communication. Feedback has been overwhelmingly positive.

#### **MBSR Program**

We continued offering this essential 8-week program to provide patients with practical tools to reduce stress, improve mood and increase their sense of empowerment.

#### **LIFE Beyond Cancer**

This 4-week program explores how to live well after cancer treatment, providing skills-building, managing fear of recurrence, reducing stress, and opportunities to connect with others.



# Patient Programming Collaborations

Our team is committed to working with our healthcare colleagues to ensure that gaps in patient services are identified and met. Together these partnerships enhance research and foster innovation, ensuring we are always offering relevant and timely programs and services for patients.


BRCA Education Programs

Health Equity & Supportive Care Research

We co-developed and co-facilitated a five-week art therapy program for young adults with cancer exploring creativity to better understand the cancer experience. InspireHealth in collaboration with BRCAinBC, BC Cancer and other experts presented a series of education sessions for patients to learn about topics related to the BRCA genes and cancer.

We continue to work with research partners such as the Thompson Rivers University, University of BC, and BC Cancer, to support invaluable research enhancing survivorship and supportive cancer care.





### **Jessica's Story**

I was diagnosed with stage 4 Lung Cancer. At that moment I knew my life would never be the same. My first thought was my then 5 year old daughter. I needed to do whatever I could to be there for her for as long as possible. But where do you start? So, I started searching for Alternative cancer therapies and I stumbled across InspireHealth's website. Another life changing moment.

InspireHealth has meant so much to me over the past year. They have armed me with an incredible knowledge base about nutrition and cancer. They have provided me with counselling support when I needed it the most. My exercise and yoga instructors help keep my fitness goals in check and the classes are fun! But most importantly, InspireHealth has created a positive support system in my life not just for me but for my family as well.

I can not recommend InspireHealth enough and I will continue to spread the word about the incredible cancer care they can offer to those in need.



# **Collaboration within Cancer Care Network**

InspireHealth recognizes the vital importance of collaboration in advancing cancer care and supporting patients throughout their journey. By working with other organizations within the cancer care space, we can provide better overall care to patients and better value to our healthcare system.

We worked with BC Cancer leadership and supportive care colleagues to better leverage our collective programs & services to help more patients during their cancer journey.

**Canadian Cancer Society** 

We conducted a nutrition program pilot to support patients and caregivers at the CCS Lodge, worked on cross-referral opportunities to aid patients in navigation, and participated in knowledge sharing at the Cancer Survivorship Research Symposium.

**UBC/VGH Gynecologic Cancer** 

Together with Dr. Lesa Dawson and partners, we contributed to an interactive Cancer Survivorship Series, addressing anxiety, sexual health, menopause, cognitive challenges, and work reintegration.





# Our Vancouver Centre Moves to Better Serve Patients

One of the highlights of the year was our move to the Centre for Cancer Prevention and Support in the heart of the 'cancer-care corridor' in Vancouver. This brought us closer to patients undergoing treatment as well as their caregivers and allowed us to more readily work with partners in the cancer care space to identify and fill gaps in the patient's cancer journey.

Over the years, she has played an integral role in increasing the awareness of the benefits of supportive care and making these essential services more accessible for patients.





We are pleased to report we ended the year with a surplus of \$120K versus a budgeted deficit of (95K). We rely on support from the Province of BC, as well as grants and donations, to enable us to serve and empower British Columbians affected by cancer. We continue to provide our services free of charge.

Total revenue for the year was \$3.2M with provincial government funding remaining consistent with the prior year at \$1.7M, or 53% of total revenue. The remainder came from fundraised dollars with the most notable amount coming from a very successful gala event.






#### Our Expenses
